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**GRADES**

Student grades will be A, B, C, D, F. No weighted grades will be issued.

**REFUNDS**

No refunds will be given after June 12th unless a class is full or cancelled. If a student is removed for disciplinary or attendance reasons, there will be **NO REFUNDS**.

**NON-RESIDENTS**

Students **NOT** residing in Westlake will be charged an additional \$35.00 per semester non-resident fee for each course taken on a space available basis.

- YOU WILL BE INFORMED IF THE CLASS REGISTERED FOR IS FULL OR WILL NOT BE OFFERED DUE TO INSUFFICIENT ENROLLMENT.
- CLASS CANCELLATIONS WILL BE COMMUNICATED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

**ATTENDANCE**

- Daily class attendance is mandatory in order for students to gain full credit for Summer School.
- If a student is absent two days during a three-week semester course they will not receive credit for the course.
- If a student is absent, his/her parent should call the school (440) 835-6352 for verification.
- Two half-day absences equal one full day of absence.
- Students arriving to school late will be counted as tardy; after 8:00 AM, a student will be considered 1/2 day absent. After 9:30 AM, no student will be admitted to class and will receive a full day absent.
- Three tardies are equal to one full day absence.
- Tardy students are to check in at the first floor attendance office.
- **ANY STUDENT WHO IS ABSENT OR TARDY MORE THAN THE NUMBER OF DAYS PERMITTED WILL NOT RECEIVE A GRADE OR CREDIT AND WILL FORFEIT TUITION.**

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**Course Offerings 2008:**

**ART**

**ART FOUNDATIONS**

Art Foundations is a general visual arts experience designed for any student. Students will be introduced to both two and three dimensional art areas. Areas may include collage, batik, tie-dye, mosaic design, paper mache, recyclable art, clay, and printmaking. \*An additional supply cost will be assessed to students.

**ENGLISH**

**ENGLISH 9**

English 9 covers the development of the communication skills of listening, writing, and organization.

**ENGLISH 10**

English 10 will help students think and reason logically and present their ideas in coherent unified writing and speaking exercises.

## **ENGLISH 11**

English 11 is a study of American literature and examines the founding, growth and changes of the American culture and the heritage it has produced.

## **ENGLISH 12**

English 12 is designed for students who enjoy reading and writing. It will reinforce basic English skills.

## **MATHEMATICS**

### **PRE-ALGEBRA**

This course is designed for those students who need additional reinforcement of their mathematics skills. The course provides the students with an integrated approach to basic concepts in algebra and geometry.

### **ALGEBRA I**

This course has emphasis placed on the development of the real number system, set notation, verbal problems, equation solving, exponents, factoring polynomials and graphing.

### **GEOMETRY**

This course is a study of points, lines and planes.

### **ALGEBRA II**

This course has emphasis placed on the development of higher mathematic skills relevant to algebraic equations.

## **SCIENCE**

### **PHYSICAL SCIENCE**

This course which focuses on scientific method, laboratory use, forces, structure of matter, chemical combining of the elements, nuclear energy, heat, magnetism, electricity, electronics, sound, light and energy for the future.

### **BIOLOGY**

This course includes cellular biology, (botany), classification of animals and genetics. Lab exercise is included.

### **CHEMISTRY**

The study of elements, compounds, equations, stoichiometry, rate of re-atoms, phases, solutions, acids & bases atomic structure, periodic behavior, chemical bonding & oxidation reduction reactions. Lab exercise is included with each unit.

## **SOCIAL STUDIES**

### **WORLD HISTORY**

This course centers on the study of the history of man, with emphasis on selected areas and periods in the western and non-western worlds.

### **AMERICAN HISTORY**

American History is a study of America from earliest times to the present.

### **GOVERNMENT (APS)**

Government is a study of governmental units at the national, state and local levels.

## **PHYSICAL EDUCATION and HEALTH**

### **PHYSICAL EDUCATION (1/4 Credit)**

Class size limited to 30 students per teacher.

Many classes will be conducted off-site and/or outside.

Be prepared for flexibility regarding facilities for Physical Education.

### **HEALTH 9 (OFFERED 1<sup>st</sup> SEMESTER ONLY)**

Students develop a process for decision making related to the following areas: human growth and development, mental and emotional health, consumer health products and services, and exercise physiology. Study of handicapped persons and chemical dependency.

### **HEALTH 10 (OFFERED 2<sup>nd</sup> SEMESTER ONLY)**

Health 10 covers CPR, basic first aid, emergency care techniques, health & safety hazards, community health, environmental health. Chemical dependency, nutrition, disease & health.
